	Method: The aim is to ensure that each organisation holding a lead quality label can organize at least one long term volunteering mobility lasting up to 12 months.
<b>Maximum grant</b>	An applicant can receive a maximum grant of: 330.000 EUR
	Method: According to the budget increase from last year, also the annual maximum grant was increased by 10% in comparison to 2021
